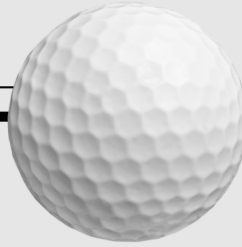

Some spring highlights included PGA Show, Kelbel Cup, Family and Friends Banquet and Tournament, Alumni Hall of Fame, and Spring Championship!

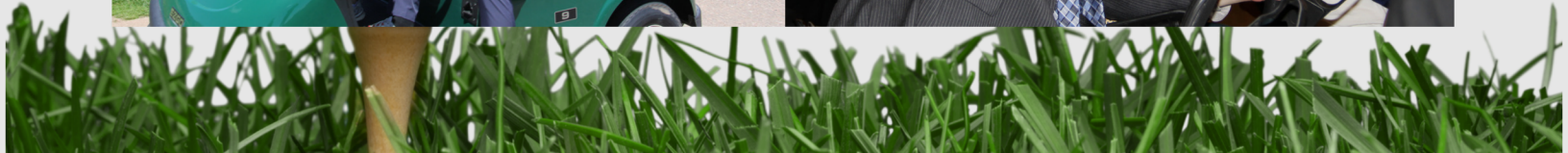

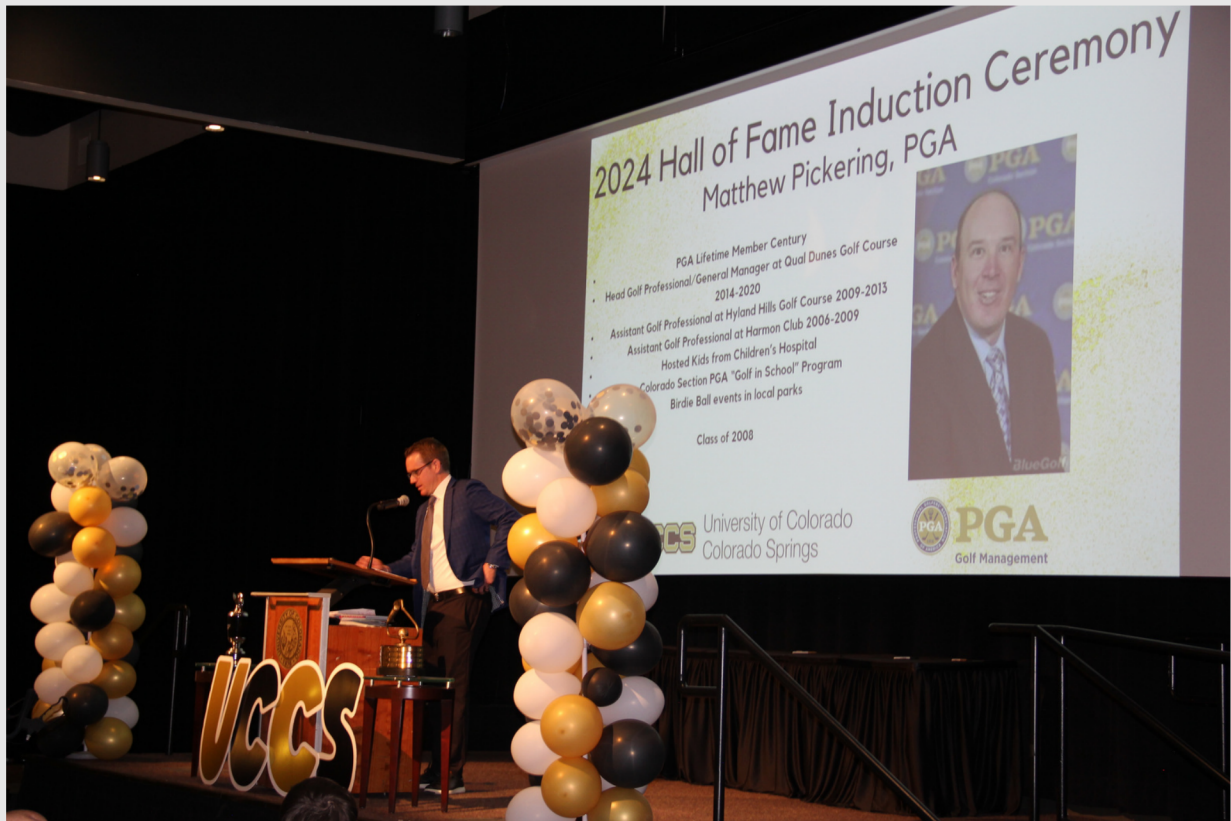
**Matt Pickering, PGA

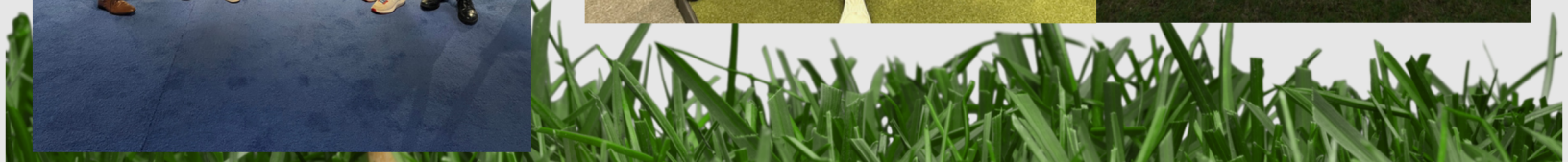
