The UCCS PGA Golf Management Hall of Fame honors individuals who through their lives, careers, service and support have made significant and enduring contributions to the PGA of America and the PGA Golf Management Program in its mission and vision.

A PGA Golf Management Hall of Fame Inductee is not required to be chosen each year, as dictated by nominations and the selection process. Up to 1 individual could be inducted each year at the annual Family & Friends Awards Event.

The categories for consideration are:

- PGA National/Section/Chapter awards**
- PGA National/Section/Chapter contributions and volunteerism**
- Community and civic impacts**
- UCCS student mentorship and/or program impacts**
- Growth of the game achievements**
- Service to PGA Members**

To be considered for induction, individuals MUST:

- Be a PGA Member in good standing**
- Have graduated from UCCS PGA Golf Management at least 10 years prior**
- Showcase notable achievements in the consideration categories**

Process & Timeline for Induction:

<i>February 1st</i>	Nominations submitted by PGA Members in good standing
<i>March 1st</i>	Nomination packets submitted by nominee
<i>March 15th</i>	Selection of Inductee by PGA Golf Management Advisory Board
<i>March 20th</i>	Inductee notified and announcement made
<i>End of Semester</i>	Induction and speech at annual Family & Friends Awards Event
