The Allure of the Dark Side continued

- Daniel A. Forbes calls the appeal of villainy "the aesthetic of evil" (14):
 - Evil / bad begs explanation (14)
 - Sympathy with villains "suggests the distinction between good and [bad] is not as clear-cut" (16)
 - Distinctions between good and evil may result from differences in ideological perspective and goals (16)
 - Evil / bad serves as a guide for how to be good (Heit 9)


