



Minors in Business – For Business Undergraduate Majors

Business students may pursue a business minor. All 9 credit hours of business courses for the minor must be taken in residence in the College of Business and must not already be counting toward an area of emphasis. If the 9 hours are not unique courses from the emphasis, then a student cannot earn a minor. Courses taken for the minor can fulfill business course requirements. A minor GPA of 2.5 must be earned, and minor courses must have a C- grade or better. *All course attempts are included in the minor GPA, but students may be eligible for [Grade Forgiveness](#). Students are responsible for completing all course requisites; requisites are strictly enforced through the registration system.*

Marketing	Any three 3000/4000 Level MKTG courses, above MKTG 3000
Organizational Social Impact	OSIM 3501, 3533, 4333 (<i>typically spring only</i>)
Service Management	HRMG 4380; MKTG 4400; OPTM 4100
