



## Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative at UCCS - Student Ethics Ambassador Program

Program requirements:

- 1. Eligible students must be an enrolled UCCS Undergraduate or Graduate Student during the award period (fall semester 2022/spring semester 2023).
- 2. The student must remain in good academic and behavior standing during award period (i.e. not on probation, no academic and student conduct violations).
- 3. The student must be eligible for student employment (enrolled half time). This is a student employment position that is paid monthly and adheres to all student employment guideless to include the maximum hours policy (no student employee can work more than 25 hours per week). This is a 5 hour per week position.
- 4. The student must complete required assignments (approximately 85 hours):
  - > Ethics Ambassador Orientation
  - > Share DFEI activities and events with students
  - > Assist or attend two DFEI events
  - Work with assigned UCCS Ethics Fellow to organize and execute one educational activity on behalf of DFEI
  - > Serve in an advisory capacity for DFEI at UCCS
